and the man said yes!

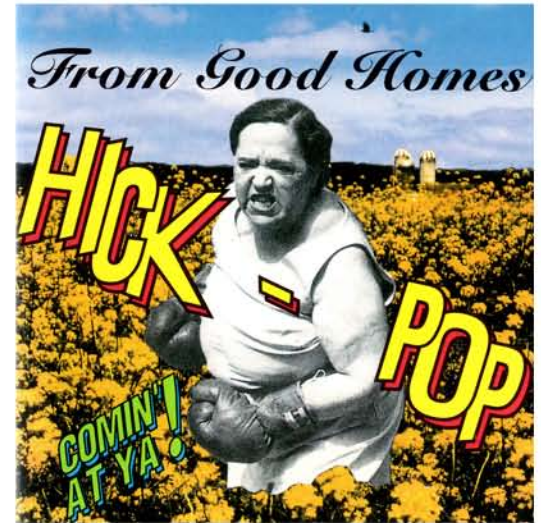
i'd like the days here
